

## **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012**

The California Department of Fish and Game annually adjusts its filing fees pursuant to Fish and Game Code Sections 711.4 and 713. Therefore, as of January 1, 2012, the Planning Department will begin collecting the following modified filing fees in the instances described below:

- 1. Projects for which a Negative Declaration is prepared require a filing fee of \$2,101.50 (an increase of \$57.50).**
- 2. Projects for which an Environmental Impact Report is prepared require a filing fee of \$2,919.00 (an increase of \$79.75).**

In addition, in accordance with Ord. No. 729, a **\$64.00 Document Handling Fee** is required to be paid to the County Clerk. Proof of payment of the appropriate filing fees, together with the Document Handling Fee, must be provided to the County Clerk at the time of filing the Notice of Determination.

Applicants with approved projects that have not had a Notice of Determination filed with the County Clerk prior to January 1, 2012, or applicants with Planning projects that will be approved within the 2012 calendar year, must submit payment and/or supplemental payment of said fees prior to a recommendation of approval for any of the above-referenced projects that will have the Notice of Determination filed at the County Clerk's office between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012.
